<b>FOOD &amp; HOSPITALITY</b>														
Takeaway orders of food including alcohol														
Outdoor hospitality, serving alcohol by table service only														
Indoor hospitality by table service only, i.e. no standing at a bar etc														
Indoor and outdoor hospitality without restriction														
Provision of shared smoking equipment such as shisha pipes														
Nightclubs (defined as dancing to music or equivalent)														
<b>SHOPS &amp; RETAILERS</b>														
Non-essential retail including clothing, homeware, electronic goods, vape stores, betting shops and car washes.														
<b>CLOSE CONTACT SERVICES</b>														
Hair, beauty and nail salons and tanning salons														
Body and skin piercing services and tattoo studios														
Spas, massage centres, acupuncture, homeopathy and reflexology														
Saunas and steam rooms														
<b>CEREMONIES</b>														
Funerals with up to 30 mourners														
Weddings, receptions, commemorative events, wakes of up to 15 people														
Weddings, receptions, commemorative events, wakes of up to 30 people														
Other types of significant life events including bar mitzvahs and christenings.														
Removal of all capacity restrictions														
<b>EVENTS</b>														
Outdoor gatherings and events, organised by a business, charity, public body or similar organisation, can be organised, subject to specific conditions: that they comply with COVID-Secure guidance including taking reasonable steps to limit the risk of transmission, complete a related risk assessment; and ensure that those attending do not mix beyond what is permitted by the social contact limits i.e. provided people do not mix beyond groups of 6 people or two households.														
Indoor gatherings and events organised by a business, charity, public body or similar organisation, can be organised, subject to specific conditions: that they comply with COVID-Secure guidance including taking reasonable steps to limit the risk of transmission, complete a related risk assessment; and ensure that those attending do not mix beyond what is permitted by the social contact limits.														
Some larger performances and sporting events will be permitted in indoor venues with large capacities														
<b>SPORTS &amp; LEISURE FACILITIES</b>														
Outdoor sports facilities, sports courts, golf, water sports, driving and shooting ranges, riding centres														
Formally organised outdoor sport but no use of indoor facilities (except toilets) and no spectators.														
Indoor leisure facilities for use by people on their own or in household groups including gyms and leisure centres, sports courts, dance studios and fitness centres														
Indoor leisure facilities use by groups of people subject to social distancing restrictions at the time														
<b>ENTERTAINMENT &amp; ATTRACTIONS</b>														
Attractions that are outdoors including adventure parks and activities, drive in events, funfairs and water parks														
Indoor entertainment venues and attractions such as cinemas, children's play areas, bingo halls, bowling alleys														
<b>ACCOMMODATION</b>														
Self-contained accommodation such as campsites and holiday lets														
Hotels, hostels and B&Bs														
<b>RESTRICTION ON INDIVIDUALS</b>														
"Stay at home" instruction lifted 29 March														
Outdoor gatherings permitted from 29 March (including in private gardens) of 6 people or 2 households														
All outdoor restrictions lifted on 18 May (only gatherings of over 30 people will remain illegal subject to exemptions)														
Indoors, the Rule of 6 or 2 households will apply from 17 May														
All legal limits on social contact removed 21 June
